- i. Bachelor's Degree from University of Juba or any Degree from the recognized institution of higher learning in related disciplines.

- iv. All applicants should come with their original academic testimonials during the interview.

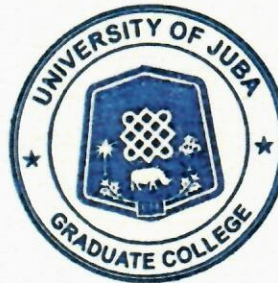
### 4. Application procedure
